

Beefeater Bulldogge's PUPPY CONTRACT

- 1) The Buyer shall provide the dog with adequate food, fresh water at all times, shelter, affection, and medical care, including all necessary shots and medication recommended by the veterinarian. The Breeder will have supplied all shots and medication recommended by a veterinarian up to the time of leaving the premises
- 2) The Breeder certifies that the sire and dam of the dog are disease free and have no known undisclosed genetic health problems.
- 3) The Buyer shall provide the dog with veterinary care upon sickness, disease, or injury, and shall take it to a veterinarian at least once a year for an annual health examination and routine vaccinations.
- 4) The Buyer shall provide the dog with humane care and maintain it in accordance with all current and future state or province, county, and municipal laws and ordinances where the Buyer resides.
- 5) The Buyer shall provide the dog with a fully fenced yard or other humane means of exercise. The dog shall not be kept constantly chained, constantly outdoors or continually crated.
- 6) The Buyer shall keep the dog as a household pet and shall never use it for breeding without the Breeder's consent. If, without previous written consent by Beefeater Bulldogges, the puppy is used to either whelp or sire a litter of puppies, the Buyer agrees to a penalty fee of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) per puppy.
- 7) The dog shall reside at the Buyer's address. The Buyer and Breeder agree to keep each other informed of their current addresses. If the dog cannot be kept by the Buyer, the Buyer shall notify the Breeder immediately. The dog shall not be sold, transferred, or given to any individual or to any retail or wholesale establishment for the purpose of sale or resale to the public, nor to any research institution where medical experimentation or other practices take place.
- 8) The Buyer agrees to take the puppy to a veterinarian within three (3) days of the date of purchase for a physical examination to determine the health of the pup.
- 9) The Buyer agrees to pay any and all shipping fees for the puppy.
- 10) The Buyer agrees that it is the Buyer's responsibility to accept the puppy as honestly described by the Breeder. The Breeder has provided and the Buyer has acknowledged a full disclosure of the health, habits, temperament of the puppy.
- 11) The Buyer agrees that the Breeder is in no way liable or responsible for any damage, accident, or injury resulting from the dog's actions or inactions.
- 12) For the life of the dog, the Buyer may return the dog to the Breeder at any time and for any reason. The Buyer agrees to sign the necessary papers to list the Breeder as sole owner of the dog if it is returned.
- 13) The Breeder agrees that any dog under one year of age with congenital or hereditary defects, that would prevent it from living a normal life, will be replaced at no cost other than shipping. Written proof from a Veterinarian of such defect must be presented (and may be verified by the seller's Veterinarian.) Should any such defect become evident within the first year, the puppy will be replaced with a comparable pup at the earliest possible time. All possible defects must be compared to another of the same breed, and not that of a different breed. No cash refund or other compensation for expenses will be given. This pup has been inspected by the seller's Veterinarian and is certified healthy at time of sale. The Buyer agrees that they will have to return the dog with a genetic health problem to qualify for replacement. This guarantee will be void if said dog is overweight, underweight or in anyway malnourished or abused.
- 14) The Buyer agrees to pay the Breeder any and all expenses, including court costs and reasonable attorney fees, in enforcing the terms and provisions of the Contract.
- 15) Should the Buyer be unable or unwilling to fulfill any of the above provisions, the Buyer agrees to return the dog to the Breeder at the Breeder's request without a refund. Should the Buyer refuse to return the dog, the Buyer hereby authorizes the Breeder to pick up and remove the dog from the Buyer's control.

The UNDERSIGNED Buyer hereby acknowledges having read the terms of the Contract and does hereby agree to abide by each of the provisions set forth above.
